Attached is some relevant historic information regarding the old station at Garub (historic image below), the purpose of the old narrow-gauge railway line to what is now the Garub 1 waterhole. This waterhole is beyond repair and the Ministry of Environment Forestry and Tourism has asked Namibia Wild Horses Foundation to fund the rebuilding of this waterhole which serves the animals grazing in the western side of the Tsau Khaeb Park.

Except for the historic image, all other images are by Scott Hurd being the historic narrow gauge railway line, the Garub station building and the solar panels and pump installation at Garub 1.
