SUBJECT: ALTERNATIVE ROUTES TO DAMAGED ROADS IN THE SOUTHERN PART

OF THE COUNTRY

The Roads Authority(RA) is pleased to announce the following alternatives routes to the roads, in the southern part of our country, that were closed due to damages by recent heavy rains:

Aroab – Keetmanshoop

Take Main Road 25 (MR 125)/C11 south of Aroab, proceed to Main Road 26 (MR26) and B1 (TR 1/2) to Keetmanshoop.

Koës to Keetmanshoop

Take District Road 614 (D 614)/C11 south of Koës, proceed to Main Road 25 (MR25), Main Road 26 (MR26) and B1 (TR 1/2) to Keetmanshoop.

Koës to Mariental

Take Main Road 30 (MR30)/C17 north of Koës, proceed to Main Road 33 (MR33)/C15 via Gochas up to Stampriet and proceed to TR 5/1 to Mariental.

Berseba to Keetmanshoop

Take Main Road 98 (MR98) east of Berseba and proceed to B1 (TR 1/3) to Keetmanshoop.

Oranjemund/Rosh Pinah to Aussenkehr/Noordoewer

Please make use of the tarred roads via Aus, Keetmanshoop and Grünau.

NB: The alternative gravel roads are accessible but with washaways that are still being repaired. However, warning signs have been installed accordingly, thus, road users are kindly requested to adhere to these signs at all times.

The RA, once again, hereby appeals to all road users to exercise extreme caution and be vigilant on their journeys, especially in areas where we have received good rains. Please report any road damages at your nearest Roads Authority Office or send an email to pr@ra.org.na.
