For Example Germany: If the Namibian 7-day incidence rate is 200 or higher, a compulsory PCR test no older than 48 hours is needed to board a plane to Germany; if it is between 50 and 199, no test needs to be done to board the plane to Germany (but certain test and quarantine restrictions apply on arrival), if the incidence is below 50, no quarantine or test restrictions apply whatsoever -> free travel

Remark: On 22 January 2021 Namibia's 7-day incidence rate stand at around 78.

Note: Normal arrival/departure form is always needed!
