UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

1. Good afternoon fellow citizens. Today, seventy-eight (78) new COVID-19 confirmed cases were identified from one thousand one hundred and sixty (1160) results received from the laboratories. This number represents a 7% positivity ratio. The gender distribution of the reported cases is forty (40) males and thirty-eight (38) females. The age range is from two (2) years to seventy-eight (78) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:

- 2. Among the forty (40) cases from Khomas region, six (6) are learners and one (1) staff member from St Joseph High school. The rest of the cases are sporadically distributed across Windhoek. The Otjozondjupa cases include three (3) health care workers.
- 3. Today we are reporting twenty-four (24) new recoveries. This brings the total number of recoveries to 13 412.
