UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL  
SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

14 July 2022

1. We announce fifteen (**15**) positive cases from four hundred and thirty-two (**432**) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a **3.5%** positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, thirteen (13) are new cases and two (2) are reinfections. The sex distribution is nine (9) males of which eight (8) are new cases and six (6) females of which five (5) are new cases. The age ranges from eight (8) years old to sixty-four (64) years.

2. Cases are reported from seven (7) regions. Among the confirmed cases are two (2) learners and one (1) student.
3. Three (3) cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, one (1) case is fully vaccinated, one (1) case is not eligible for vaccination and ten (10) cases are not vaccinated.
4. Eleven (11) cases from three (3) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is one hundred and thirty-six (136). Twenty-five (25) cases are currently hospitalized in six (6) regions of which one (1) is in ICU. None of the hospitalized cases is vaccinated.

6. We are reporting one (1) COVID-19 related death. A 90-year-old female from Okongo district with commodities died at home on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2022. The deceased was not vaccinated.
7. By 13 July 2022, a total of **489 412** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **33.2%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **163 445** have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **266 533** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **429 978** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **29.2 %** of the target population.
8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (**128**) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccine and seventy-six (**76**) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (**204**) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
9. Twenty-four thousand five hundred and ten (**24 510**) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing **8.0%** of the target population (307 298). Of these, twelve thousand four hundred and seventy-seven (**12 477**) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is **513 922** of which **442 379** are fully vaccinated, translating to **24.8%** of the total target population (1 779 271).
10. Seventy-eight thousand eight hundred and eighteen (**78 818**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below.
