UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA

17 June 2022 WINDHOEK

1. We announce ninety (90) positive cases from one thousand one hundred and thirty-seven (1 137) results in the last twenty-four (24) hour reporting cycle, representing a 7.9% positivity ratio. Of these positive cases, eighty-four (84) are new cases and six (6) are reinfections. The sex distribution is fifty (50) females of which forty-nine (49) are new cases and forty (40) males of which thirty-five (35) are new cases. The age ranges from seven (7) months to ninety-four (94) years.

- 2. Cases are reported from twelve (12) regions. Among the confirmed cases, are eleven (11) learners from different schools, eight (8) health care workers, two (2) students and, one (1) teacher.
- 3. Two (2) cases have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, twenty-two (22) cases are fully vaccinated of which four (4) have received a booster dose, eight (8) cases are not eligible, fifty-eight (58) cases are not vaccinated.
- 4. Two hundred and thirty-three (233) cases from eleven (11) regions have recovered.

5. The number of active cases is one thousand two hundred and fourteen (1 214). Fifty-one (51) cases are currently hospitalized in nine (9) regions of which four (4) are in ICU. One (1) of the hospitalized case has received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, four (4) are fully vaccinated, and none of the ICU admissions is vaccinated.

- 6. We are reporting two (2) COVID-19 deaths. A 12-years old female from Eenhana district with no commodities, died on 14 June 2022. She was not vaccinated. The other one (1) is a 73 years old female from Rundu district with known commodities, who died on 15 June 2022. She had received Jansen vaccine. Both died at health facilities.
- 7. By 16 June 2022, a total of **470 659** people aged 18 years and older have received one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, representing **32.0%** of the target population (1 471 973). A total of **148 073 have** received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while **264 286** adults have received two doses of other vaccine types. Hence, **412 359** adults have completed their vaccination, translating to **28.0** % of the target population.

- 8. A total of one hundred and twenty-eight (128) individuals have received component one of the Sputnik V vaccines and seventy-six (76) have received component two of the same vaccine. Hence, a total of two hundred and four (204) doses of Sputnik V were administered. This is included in the grand totals above.
- 9. Twenty-three thousand four hundred and seventy-five (23 475) children aged 12-17 years have received one dose of the Pfizer vaccine, representing 8.0% of the target population (307 298). Of these, eleven thousand eight hundred and ninety-five (11 895) are fully vaccinated. Hence, the cumulative number of people vaccinated with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine for both adults and children is 494 134 of which 424 254 are fully vaccinated, translating to 24.0% of the total target population (1 779 271).
- 10. Seventy-one thousand one hundred and sixty-five (**71 165**) people have received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose. Details of vaccinations are presented in tables 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 below
