01 November 2020

WINDHOEK *Check against Delivery Good afternoon compatriots. Today, fifty-three (53) confirmed COVID-19 cases were identified from a total of nine hundred and thirty-one (931) results received from the testing laboratories. The gender distribution of the cases is twenty-nine (29) males and twenty-four (24) females. The age range is from thirteen (13) to sixty-eight (68) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:

- 1. The confirmed cases from Oshakati District are still coming from institutions. Twenty-three (23) are inmates from Oluno Correctional Facility and nine (9) are learners from Okaukwejo Combined School.
- 2. Today we are reporting 2 new recoveries, one each from Hardap and Karas regions. This brings the total number of recoveries to 11,038.
- 3. The total number of active cases now stands at **1,817.** Of the active cases, three (3) are in severe condition.
