WINDHOEK *Check against Delivery 1. Good afternoon fellow compatriots. Today, twenty-four (24) confirmed COVID-19 cases were identified from five hundred and one (501) results received from the testing laboratories. The gender distribution of the cases is sixteen (16) males and eight (8) females. The age range is from two (2) to sixty-one (61) years. The new COVID-19 cases are distributed as follows:
