WINDHOEK *Check against Delivery 1. Good afternoon fellow Namibians. Today, we have received a total number of 1 150 results. Seventy-eight (78) samples tested positive for COVID-19. The gender ratio is fifty-seven (57) males to twenty-one (21) females. The ages ranges from two (2) years to eight-five (85) years. The confirmed cases are distributed as follows:

- 2. Among the 26 cases reported from Hardap Region, 25 are inmates from Hardap Correctional facility. Among the 15 cases from Oshana region, 13 are inmates from Oluno Correctional facility. Among the 5 cases reported from Oshikoto Region, 4 are from Omuthiya police holding cell.
- 3. Today we are reporting 27 new recoveries. This brings the total recoveries to 10 775.
