WINDHOEK *Check against Delivery Good afternoon fellow Namibians. Today, we have received 967 results. Nineteen (19) these samples tested positive for COVID-19. Thirteen (13) are females while six (6) are males. The youngest is four (4) years and the oldest is seventy-five (75) years. The confirmed cases are distributed as follows:
