

UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

1. Good afternoon fellow Namibians. We have received 1035 results. Forty-one (41) samples tested positive for COVID-19. The gender ratio is twenty-seven (27) males to fourteen (14) females. The age ranges from two (2) year to seventy-one (71) years. The confirmed cases are distributed as follows:

- 2. All 15 cases are inmates from Omuthiya police holding cells. The Hardap cases include four inmates from Hardap Correctional facility.
- 3. Today we are reporting 139 new recoveries. This brings the total recoveries to 10,748.
