Good evening Fellow Namibians! We have twenty eight (28) new cases. Twenty-seven are from Walvis Bay. One (1) from our quarantine facility in Okahandja who came from Walvis Bay. Twenty (20) are males and 8 are females. The youngest is 5 year and oldest is 61 years. All are Namibians. They are all in stable conditions. Contact tracing is ongoing.
