- 1. Good evening Fellow Namibians! We have recorded fifteen new cases of Covid-19. They are all Namibians from Walvis Bay. Thirteen (13) are females and two are (2) males. The youngest one is 4 years and oldest one is 51 years old. Nine (9) are contacts of confirmed cases. Twelve (12) had symptoms consistent with COVID-19 at the time of specimen collection. Four were identified through active case search. They are all in stable condition. Contact tracing is ongoing.
- 2. During the morning update, I erroneously indicated that only one case was from Windhoek. In fact, there are two cases from Windhoek and not one. The second case is that of a patient who was referred from Walvis Bay to Windhoek. The specimen was collected and tested in Windhoek. Therefore this is a Windhoek case.
