



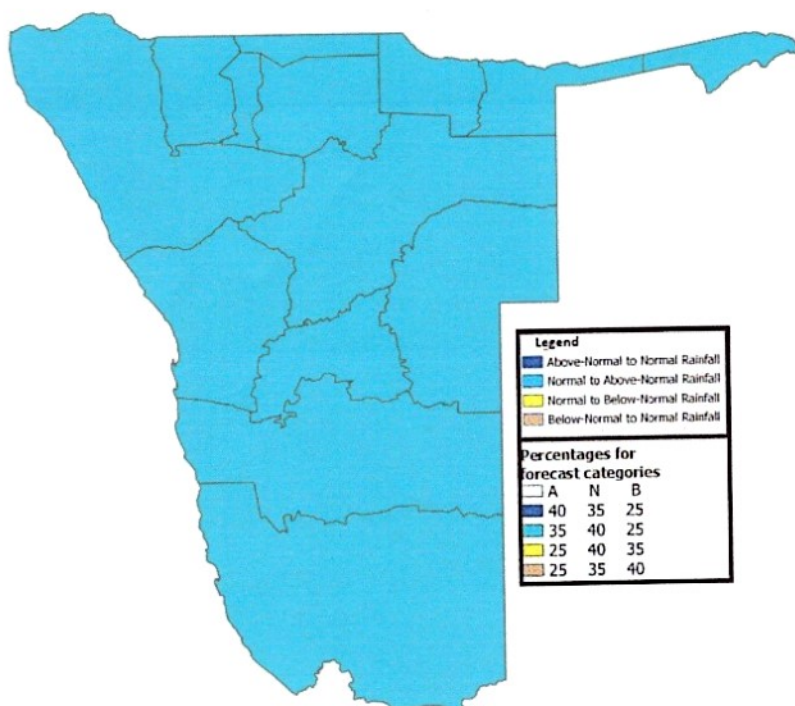

SEASONAL RAINFALL OUTLOOK
ISSUED BY
METEOROLOGICAL SERVICE DIVISION OF NAMIBIA FOR THE
DECEMBER 2022 TO MAY 2023 PERIOD ON
15 DECEMBER 2022

During December 2022, the Sea Surface Temperatures (SST) over central and eastern equatorial Pacific Ocean were observed to be a continuation of La Nina events. On average, most models predict 75% presence of a La Nina event over the Eastern Equatorial Pacific Ocean thus indicating normal to above normal rainfall during December 2022 to May 2023.

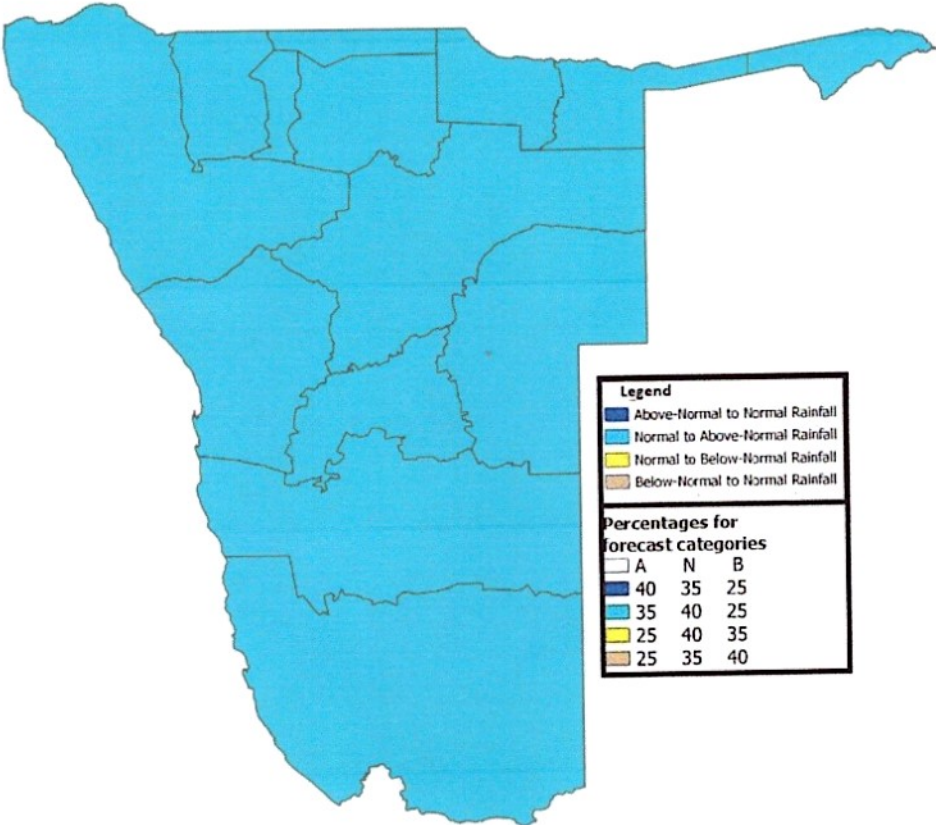
Forecast for DJF 2023

Normal to above normal rainfall is expected across the entire country.



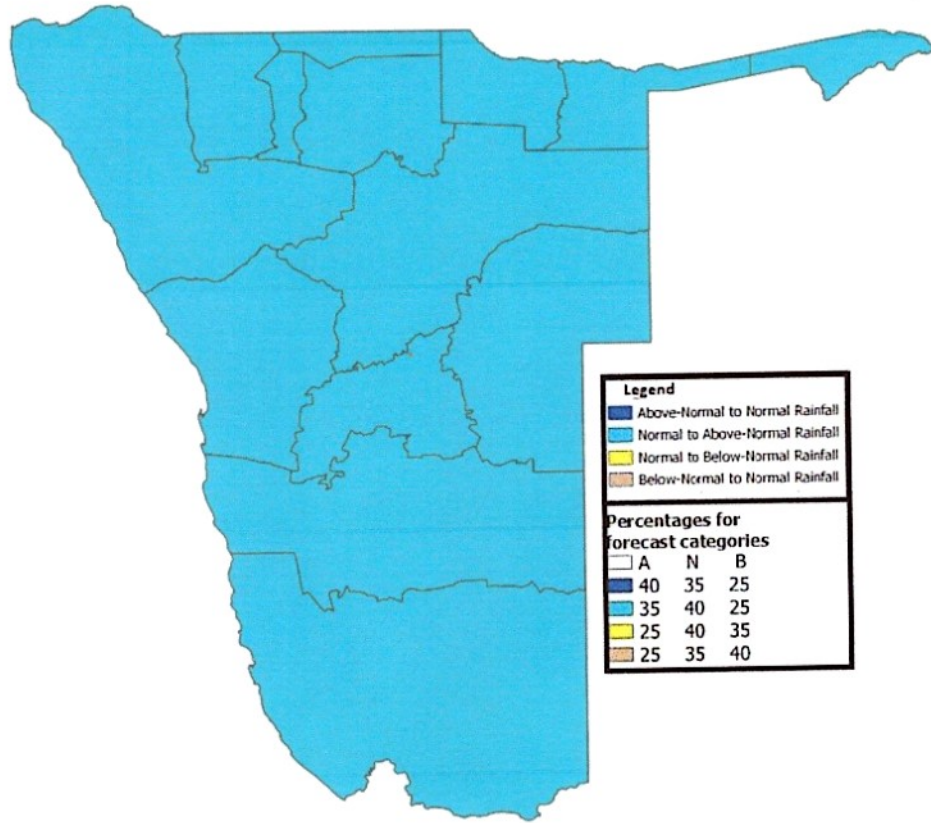
Forecast for JFM 2023

Normal to above normal rainfall is expected across the entire country.



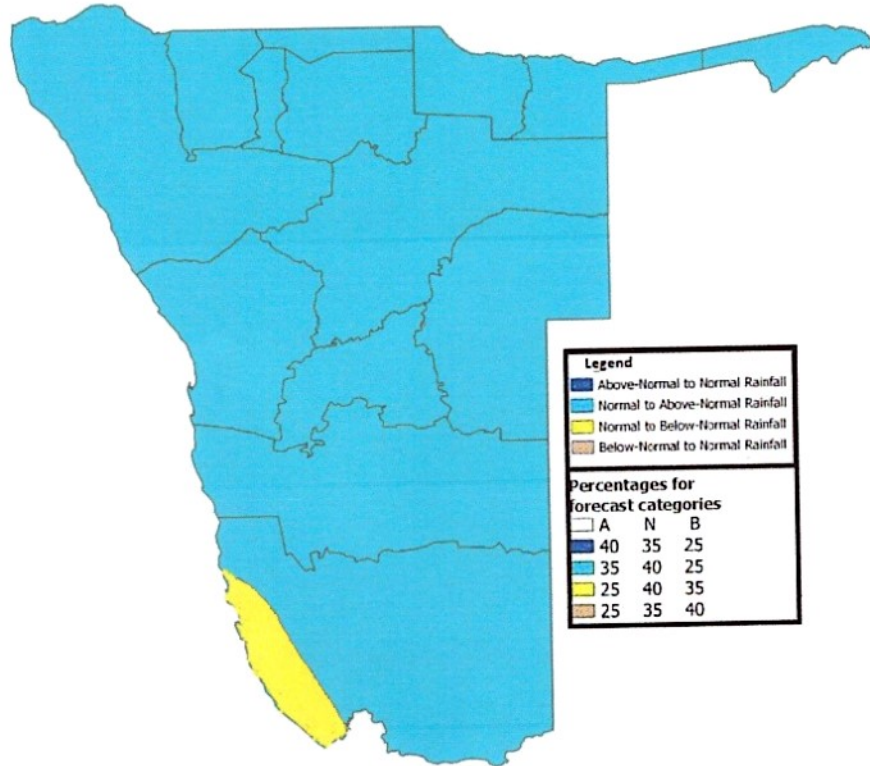
Forecast for FMA 2023

Normal to above normal rainfall is expected across the entire country.



Forecast for MAM 2023

Normal to above normal rainfall is expected across the entire country except over the extreme southwestern part where normal to below normal rainfall is expected.
