UPDATE BY DR. KALUMBI SHANGULA, MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ON COVID-19 IN NAMIBIA.

Good morning Fellow Namibians! We are reporting eight (8) new cases; all are Namibians from Walvis Bay. Four are males and four are females. The youngest one is 13 years and oldest one is 44 years. Four are contacts of confirmed cases. Four had COVID-19 related symptoms at the time of specimen collection. They are all in stable conditions. Contact tracing is ongoing.

I shall now present the cases individually.

1. Case No 286

A 28-years old female and a contact to a confirmed case. She was tested on the 24 June 2020. She had no symptoms consistent with COVID-19 at the time the specimen was collected from her.

2. Case No 287

A 26-years old male and a contact to a confirmed case. He was tested on the 26 June 2020. He presented with symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

3. Case No 288

A 13-years old female and a contact to a confirmed case. She was tested on the 26 June 2020. She had no symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

4. Case No 289

A 30-years old female and a contact of a confirmed case. She was tested on the 26 June 2020. She presented with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 at the time of specimen collection.

5. Case No 290

A 43-years old female and a contact to a confirmed case. She was tested on the 26 June 2020. She had no symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

6. Case No 291

A 44-years old male with no known contact to a confirmed case. He was tested on the 30 June 2020. He had no symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

7. Case No 292

A 33-years old male with no known contact to a confirmed case. He was tested on the 30 June 2020 as he presented with symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

8. Case No 293

A 41-years old male with no known contact to a confirmed case. He was tested on the 29 June 2020 as he presented with symptoms consistent with COVID-19.
