1. Good morning dear Compatriots. We have recorded seventy-three (73) new cases of Covid-19, all are Namibians. One is from Windhoek and the rest are from Walvis Bay, Erongo region. The one in Windhoek is a 44-year old male, with history of having travelled from Walvis Bay. He is currently in quarantine. Thirty-seven (37) are females and thirty-six (36) are males. The youngest one is 5 years and oldest one is 55 years. They are all in stable conditions. Contact tracing is ongoing.
