1. Good morning dear Compatriots. Namibia has recorded fifty-four (54) new cases of Covid-19. All cases are of Namibian nationals and all are from Walvis Bay. Thirty-five are (35) females and nineteen (19) are males. The youngest one is 5 years old and the oldest one is 60 years. They are all in stable conditions. Contact tracing is ongoing to establish the possible source.
2. One Namibian truck driver was tested in Botswana on his way from South Africa. He was admitted in isolation in Gobabis hospital. He was tested again and his result came out positive again. Although he is being managed here, we are not adding him to the Namibian cases as he was already counted in Botswana.
3. The summary of the report is as follow:
